Academy Assistant Coaches

Kent Netball is seeking to add additional coaching support to enhance its coaching team for the 2021-22 Academy Programme and is looking for Assistant Coaches for its academies.

Kent Netball runs an Academy programme that is part of the England Netball Performance Pathway, and consists of U15 and U13 Academies.

The Academies have up to 3 training centres, per age group, across the county. Each centre delivers 40 hours of coaching from October through to March. There will be approximately 20 athletes at each centre.

Key responsibilities include:

- Support the Head Coach in delivering training sessions
- Liaise with the Head to coach to manage and monitor athlete performance
- Attend Kent Netball Performance Group meetings and events

Successful applicants will have*:

- Minimum Level 1 EN / UKCC Coaching Qualification
- Experience of working with junior athletes preferably in the U13 and U15 age groups
- Experience of supporting the delivery of coaching sessions
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills
- Be committed to improving performance and developing Netball at all levels.
