

Kent Netball Management Committee Role Profile YOUTH REPRESENTATIVE

Introduction

The following role profile is not intended to be comprehensive, nor is it an expectation that potential volunteers will possess all the skills/personal qualities listed.

The role of Youth Representative is appointed by the KNMC and held by the appointed official for two years.

This role profile should be read in conjunction with the Kent Netball Management Committee - Roles, Skills and Personal Qualities document which outlines the requirements of all KNMC officers.

The Youth Representative's role is to:

- report to the Chairperson;
- contribute to meeting of the KNMC from a youth perspective;
- take on leadership of the Youth Working Group;
- work with KNMC to identify new young talent for future leaders/volunteers;
- prepare a report of the year's activities for the AGM; and
- champion the Young Volunteer Award.

Skills/Personal Qualities required of the Youth Representative:

This role will suit someone who is enthusiastic with a good knowledge of netball. They will need initiative, drive and be resourceful. They will ideally have website and social media skills. They will hold evidence of, or will be willing to successfully undertake, safeguarding training.

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
