

Can I miss one of the trial dates?

Whilst we understand not being able to attend trials can be disappointing, we have a strict policy in place that requires all athletes to attend all trial dates, if selected to do so.

We try to give as much notice as possible of our trial dates. We also have an ongoing scouting process which enables athletes to be scouted for a trial at any point through the programme.

Do I need to register to attend trials?

Yes, ALL trialists must have completed the online Registration form to secure a place at trials.

Trialists are also required to be nominated by their school or netball club.

Please do not attend if you have not completed this process as you will not have been included in the schedule.

I am a current Kent PDP athlete. Do I need to register to attend trials?

Yes. If you are an existing PDP athlete you are required to complete the individual registration. You do **NOT** need a club or school nomination.

I've registered. Do I get a confirmation email?

We do not send confirmation emails to individuals due to the volume. On successfully submitting your registration, and making payment, there will be a notification on screen of your registration. This will have added you to our Trial Registration and we will see you on Trials day.

Do I have to pay by PayPal?

No. If you click on PayPal checkout you should then get then get an option to login/create an account, **OR** pay by debit or credit card. This does not require the set up of any accounts to PayPal.

Can I trial if I am based in another county?

Yes. However athletes must be able to travel to our training venues on a weekly basis. Our locations are published on the Academies page of our website.

The Player Development Programme is subsidised by Kent Netball. Any trialists that are not members of Kent (through their EN membership) will not benefit from the subsidised programme rates or bursary schemes.

When will I be advised on the outcome of my trial?

All trialists will be sent an email within a week of their trial with their outcome. The exact date will be confirmed to all athletes at the trial.

Will I receive feedback if I am unsuccessful at trials?

No, due to the volume of athletes trialling we are unable to provide feedback as standard. However if you specifically require feedback after your trial you can contact us on performance@kentnetball.couk

Is there space for spectators at trials?

Parents are welcome stay and watch trials. There will be separate athlete areas in which the athletes will remain for the duration of the event. Parents will need to remain in the spectator areas.

There is parking at both venues. Dogs are not allowed on site at Rainham School.

Do you have trials for U16/U17s?

The county PDP is for U13 and U15 athletes. The next step on the Performance Pathway is the franchise academies.

The franchise U17 Academies run open trials, usually in September. Any athlete can attend these and you will need to register individually through the franchise's trial application process. Details are provided on Franchise websites at the time.
